ECONOMICS — Effects on PPC

6. Increase in population or labour force

7. Fall in technology/efficiency of one sector
8. Discovery of new natural resources
9. Shortage of specialised labour in one industry
10. Improvement in overall technology
11. Migration of labour to other countries
12. Skilled workers trained only for one industry

13. Destruction of factories or machinery
14. Ban on raw material used in one industry
15. Better education and skill development
16. War or pandemic reducing resources
17. New technology only in agriculture
18. Increase in availability of natural resources
